## **A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

Dalgoma Anchalik College was a vision turned into reality for the knowledge thirsty masses of Dalgoma and nearby vicinities in Goalpara district, also covering some char areas of Barpeta district. On 25<sup>th</sup> of August 1993, the college was established after a prolonged effort as well as joint initiative of the Sponsoring and Governing Body and the general public under the able leadership of Late Ratneswar Das, the then MLA and Chairman of Assam Khadi and Village Industries Board, Assam. The college is located attractively at mid-place of Matia and Dalgoma, 13 km to the north from Dudhnoi, Head Quarter of Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council and 28 km to the east from Goalpara, the Sadar Town of Goalpara District. It is surrounded with the basic amenities like revenue circle office, development block office, police station, post office, banks, hospitals and road communication.

Dalgoma Anchalik College, an Undergraduate (Degree) Arts College affiliated to Gauhati University, Guwahati, obtained first Government Concurrence in the year 1995 and final Government Concurrence in the year 1998. The college is under the umbrella of “Assam Venture Educational Institution (Provincialization of Services) Act, 2011 and Amended, 2012”, and provincialised with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2013 by the Government of Assam. The college is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and under section 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956.

On the march of progress, despite many odds, the college is getting ahead in cooperation with the various committees of teachers, employees and students, members of the hon’ble governing body of the college, alumni as well as the local leadership. With a view to catering to the need of higher education, major courses in all six subjects were introduced in the college since its inception. Here, the examination centre for the undergraduate level (B. A.) has been running without interruption since 1998. The students from a very alarming socio-economic condition with a poor educational facilities have been showing shining results in the examinations only with their own endeavour and the contribution of the industrious teachers. The ready reference may be viewed easily in the scene of their higher degrees and placement in various engagements of our beloved alumni. Our Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been upholding constant pains in this regard.

The then Chief Minister of Assam, Late Hiteswar Saikia laid the foundation stone of the college building on 3rd November, 1993 and it was later inaugurated on the 15th of July, 1995. So far as the academic as well as infrastructural facilities are concerned, the college has a library with a good number of books, journals, magazines, newspapers, reading room, laboratory (Education), vast playground, principal’s chamber, office room, boys common room and girls common room, separate departmental chambers, bicycle stand, separate toilet for boys and girls, running water facility and so on.

## **ADMISSION: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

### **I. FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) COURSES:**

For admission into UG (Arts) course, a candidate must pass Higher Secondary or any other equivalent examinations from any recognized institution.

II. Candidates selected must take admission within the scheduled time.

III. The concerned department will take the final decision in the selection of candidates in Major.

IV. The decision of the Admission/Academic committee regarding any admission shall be final.

For all the courses, selection will be made on merit basis through selection procedure by the College authority.

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

### 1. College Hours: From 9 A.M. To 4.15 P.M.

2. **Identity Card:** Containing relevant information and photograph of the students a non refundable identity card will be issued to the students every academic year.

3. **Maintenance of Discipline:** In matters of healthy practices, the college gives high priority to maintenance of discipline in the college campus. The following rules have been framed in this regards:

- (i) Use of mobile or cell phones inside the college campus by students is restricted.
- (ii) Ragging is “human rights abuse in essence”. All forms of ragging in college campus are prohibited. Strong disciplinary action will be taken if anyone is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging.
- iii) Students must not unnecessarily roam in the corridors. The college authority may take strong action in this regard.
- iv) Students must maintain silence and discipline in the reading room of the library. In no way they should indulge in gossiping and non-academic activities. Violation of these norms may lead to cancellation of library membership.
- v) Students must wear uniform during college hours.
- vi) Students must carry valid identity card within the college campus.
- vii) Consumption of gutka, pan masalsa or any other intoxicants in the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- viii) Students shall park their own bicycle/bike/car etc. at their own risks and at proper place.
- ix) No student is allowed to leave the college without finishing the respective classes without prior permission of the college authority.
